- Also called "Christmas Cheer," I get my name from the cute jelly bean-shaped leaves along my stems that range in color from a beautiful green to shades of red and pink.
- I can grow up to 6 inches tall and spread up to 36 inches wide, and I even grow small yellow flowers in the summertime!
- I thrive best in dry soil and areas with intense sunlight. Any fallen leaves will easily propagate, so just nestle them halfway into my soil. They'll eventually sprout roots and grow new plants!
